

# Advancing T7 recommendations: key milestones and meetings

Following three months of intensive collaboration with 50 think tanks from around the world during the 2025-2026 T7 process, IDDRI is continuing throughout 2026 to promote and disseminate the T7 recommendations across key international forums where policy debates take shape and decisions are made. Through high-level meetings, roundtables, conferences and dedicated events, we are engaging with governments, international organizations, research communities and civil society actors to help translate these recommendations into policy discussions and decision-making processes.
